

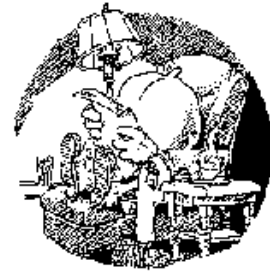

MILI WHITE REMEMBERED

The Register-Guard obituaries of July 13th recorded the passing of Growers member Mili White due to age-related causes at age 88. The R-G notes, "She was an environmental and social justice activist."

A celebration of life potluck will be at 6 p.m. July 21 at Lamb Cottage in Skinner Butte Park in Eugene for Mildred B. "Mili" White of Eugene, who died July 7 of age-related causes. She was 88.

She was born Feb. 2, 1924, in Stockton, Calif., to Joseph and Elizabeth Fishelman Berger. She attended college. She was an environmental and social justice activist. Survivors include two sons, Irving White of Stockton and Curtis White of Tumwater, Wash.
